

**CONSTITUTION
THE HARROW ART SOCIETY**

Feb. 2002

1. The Society shall be called "The Harrow Art Society".
2. The object shall be the encouragement of an interest in the visual arts and crafts by arranging exhibitions of original works by members and also lectures, criticisms and other means.
3. Membership of the Society shall be open to all.
4. The officers of the Society shall be President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Exhibition Secretary, Treasurer, Programme Secretary, Publicity Secretary, Minutes Secretary.
5. **Subscriptions.** The annual subscription shall be determined at the AGM and payable in February.
6. **Exhibitions.** All works submitted must be original in design, conception and execution, and a declaration by each member shall be given to that effect on the entry form. A commission shall be charged by the Society on the price of any works sold at any exhibition, or otherwise through the agency of the Society. No works shall be accepted by the Society for exhibition by a member whose subscription for the current year is unpaid.
7. **Accounts and Annual General Meeting.**
 - a) The financial year shall end on 31st December.
 - b) The AGM shall be held not later than the 28th February: to receive the report of the Committee and the audited accounts for the past year; to elect officers, Committee and Auditor for the coming year; to transact general business.
 - c) All proposed resolutions, including amendments to rules, shall be received by the Secretary, in writing, three weeks before the AGM.
 - d) The Secretary shall send to all members not less than 14 days before the date of the AGM a notice of that meeting together with any proposed resolutions which have been duly submitted.
8. On a written request, by no fewer than ten members, the Secretary shall convene an Extraordinary General Meeting giving at least fourteen days' notice.
9. These rules may only be altered or rescinded at a General Meeting by a majority of the members present.
